## THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SEBA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

## **BY-LAW NO. 1-2018**

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE USE OF FERTILIZERS AND HERBICIDES.

WHEREAS in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, Part 2 Sections 7 & 8 and amendments thereto, authorizes the Council of a local Municipality to pass a Bylaw regulating the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property;

AND WHEREAS there is a desire for all municipalities around Wabamun Lake to have restrictions on the use of lawn fertilizers;

AND WHEREAS the Summer Village of Seba Beach would encourage other municipalities around the lake to pass similar bylaws;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council of the Summer Village of Seba Beach, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The use of fertilizers other than natural compost on lawns is prohibited within the Summer Village of Seba Beach
- All chemical herbicides are prohibited within the Summer Village of Seba Beach except for the control of noxious and prohibited noxious weeds as defined in the Weed Control Act
- 3. This By-law comes into effect on the date of the third reading
